General Functions:

Assist with the expansion and support of our before-school and after-school programs. Participate in all required AmeriCorps meetings, trainings, and activities.

Specific Duties May Include:

- Assist Site Coordinators with the development and delivery of the after-school program activities (i.e. delivering Camp Fire curriculum, enrichment activities such as photography, drama, or arts and crafts).
- Recruit volunteers to facilitate enrichment and small group activities.

- Good organization skills, presents self in a professional manner, and is outgoing and personable
